- Knowledge of advanced stability
- Stress out the importance of environment and environment protection
- Knowledge of meteorology
- Apply specific knowledge on the field of Search and Rescue
- How to respond to a distress alert – SAR missions
- Knowledge of SAR Communications
- Security awareness and knowledge in designated security duties and responsibilities
- Apply specific knowledge on “Voyage planning with ECDIS”
- Knowledge on how to gain Situation Awareness
- Knowledge of Leadership and Team-working
- The ability to make decisions, which promote the safety and efficiency of an operational plant.
- Knowledge of a Safe navigational watch and use of navigational equipment
- Knowledge of blind pilotage techniques

- Certificate of competency
- ECDIS Generic certificate (IMO Model course 1.27)
- BTM Certificate (IMO Model course 1.22)

- Medical awareness certificate
