



**Course Title:** SAR ON – SCENE COORDINATOR (IAMSAR MANUAL, VOLUME III)  
based on IMO Model Course 3.15 (Edition 2014)

**Duration:** 5 Days (09:30 – 17:00)

**Target Group(s):** MASTERS AND CHIEF OFFICERS (MANAGEMENT LEVEL)

#### Scope & Objectives:

- Overview and basis of a SAR Service
- Rendering assistance (SAR mission)
- Training and Consolidation of above listed topics
- Teamwork
- Problems for an OSC arising from complex SAW missions and tools to cope with such challenges
- Training and Consolidation of above listed topics
- Coordinating operations of all SAR facilities on scene
- Receiving the search action or rescue plan from the SMC and modifying it
- Coordinating on-scene communications
- Ensuring that operations are conducted safely
- Keeping the SMC advised with periodic situation reports e.g. regarding rescue plan modification, number and name of survivors, names and designations of facilities with survivors aboard, which survivor is in each facility etc.
- Advising the SMC to release facilities which are no longer required or requesting additional assistance if it's necessary

#### Entry Requirements:

- Seaman Book No, Passport No and Medical Card.
- 2 Photos
- Certificate of competency

#### Gained Qualifications:

This course aims the participants to gain knowledge that will qualify participants to effectively execute the Coordination of Search and Rescue Operations, the Initial action(s) by assisting craft and the Search and Rescue procedures and tasks.

It is conducted by experienced in IAMSAR Specialists.

It is supported by our state-of-the-art Full Mission Bridge Simulator with some indicative virtual scenarios such as action as an OSC within fictitious but realistic simple or complex SAR situations, adaption of a search action plan according to given local conditions and verification of the different suggestions given when acting as an OSC.
